Models are supplied on the day. If you wish to bring your own model, he will be required from 1:30pm on the afternoon of training. All models must be over 18 years of age and will need to complete a health consultation before waxing can take place. Please let us know at the time of booking if you intend to bring your own model.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: What is peelable wax? What's so great about this new generation of waxes?

A: You may have heard it referred to as non-strip wax, hard wax, film wax or hot wax. Traditional hot wax is applied in a thick layer or built up over several layers, usually in a figure-of-eight pattern to ensure a thorough coating of all hairs. It is left to cool and harden on the skin and is then removed by hand, taking the encapsulated hair with it. The latest generation of peelable waxes provide perfect epilation of all hair types, even on sensitive areas. They share the unique 'shrink wrapping' abilities of older hot waxes but are lower in temperature, easier to apply and stay flexible as they dry. This makes them much more comfortable for the client and an ideal choice for removing short, coarse and stubborn hairs anywhere on the body. To ensure you are fully equipped to offer your clients the very best and most comfortable Brazilian wax possible, the peelable wax method is the technique we teach on all Axiom classes.

Q: I've never used peelable wax before, is that a problem?

A: Our workshops are open to all qualified hair removal technicians, regardless of the brand you currently use or your preferred technique. An introduction to peelable waxes will be provided on the day, and there will be plenty of time to practice your skills during the remainder of the workshop. For those that enjoy using the products, we have negotiated special discounts on starter kits from Ashmira Botanica, exclusive to Axiom graduates.

Q: Do I need to bring anything with me on the day?

A: Please bring a notepad and pen with you. As this is a practical class, you will need to be dressed appropriately in a salon uniform or similar professional workwear (trousers and a t-shirt or polo shirt are fine). If supplying your own model, he will need to be available from 1:30pm. Light refreshments and all waxing supplies needed for the duration of training are provided by us. Lunch is not included but you may bring your own food with you or take advantage of the many cafés and sandwich shops nearby.

Q: Does this workshop cover female Brazilian waxing?

A: No, we offer separate training in female intimate waxing. Contact us for more information.

Q: Do you issue a certificate and is your training recognised by insurance providers?

A: Yes, upon successful completion of all assessment activities you will be issued with a certificate of achievement in male intimate waxing. Treatment and public liability insurance is then available from several UK providers, including the Guild of Beauty Therapists.

Q: Is this course suitable for beginners?

A: This class is open to male and female therapists aged 18+ who hold a basic waxing qualification. If you are new to waxing, our 2-day beginner's course provides the perfect grounding for your hair removal career.
