

INFORMATION FOR MALE WAXING MODELS

The team at Axiom Wax Academy are male grooming specialists, committed to providing the highest quality education for fellow therapists in the art of men's waxing.

We are currently looking for male models around the UK for our popular face, body and Brazilian waxing workshops.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

We run classes every month and need male models in Hampshire, Manchester and the Midlands for any (or all!) of the following:

- Facial waxing (eyebrows, ears, nostrils)
- Body waxing (chest, abs, back, shoulders, legs, underarms)
- Intimate waxing (groin and buttocks)

You can volunteer to be a demonstration model or a practice model, but ideally you will have previous experience of waxing so that you know what to expect.

Demonstration models will be waxed by a male or female tutor. In the case of group workshops, techniques will be demonstrated in front of a small class of students that may include both male and female attendees.

Practice models will be waxed by students and overseen at all times by a tutor. Students are all over 18 years of age and may include both male and female therapists.

Body waxing techniques are performed using a mixture of peelable wax (a.k.a. hot wax) and strip wax. All facial and intimate waxing is carried out using peelable wax.

We are unable to pay models or reimburse travel costs, but your wax treatment is always free of charge and you will also receive free aftercare products to help look after your skin at home.

RESTRICTIONS

All models must be over 18 years of age and are required to complete a confidential health consultation before waxing can take place.

Contagious or infectious skin conditions will prevent us from waxing the affected area until the condition has completely cleared (for intimate waxing, this includes STIs and urinary tract infections).

Clients taking Roaccutane must wait 6 months after finishing their medication before receiving a waxing treatment.

We are unable to remove hair from skin that is sunburnt, chafed or broken, or from skin that has been treated with steroid creams, Retin-A, Differin or other retinoid acne medication within the last 3 months.

Waxing is not suitable for people with lymph oedema in the treatment area, severe haemophilia, or those with diabetes that is not managed by diet, exercise or medication.

HOW TO PREPARE FOR YOUR TREATMENT

Upon agreeing a date, we will contact you with directions to the training venue and an arrival time for the class. Please let us know as soon as possible if you can't make it or if you are running late on the day itself.

Please shower before your appointment and gently exfoliate the areas you are having waxed for a couple of days beforehand. This helps to remove any dead skin cells and lifts the hair for better results. Changing facilities and wet wipes are available for you to freshen up with before your treatment, at all of our training venues.

Do not trim, shave or use hair removal creams (e.g. Veet) on the area for at least 3 weeks prior to your appointment, as hair needs to be a minimum of ½ cm long in order to wax successfully. If you are already getting waxed on a regular basis, you will need to leave at least 4 weeks between treatments.

You will not be able to sunbathe or exercise for 24 hours after your appointment, so please bear this in mind when making plans.
